He works there from 2 to 4 p.m. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays.

At Schowalter, he's made friendly acquaintances.

When Goerzen started volunteering there, he went through an orientation "where they tell you the basics and about HIP-PA and stuff," he said.

One of the things Goerzen recalls happening between him and a resident is the resident saw a cat walking with a kitten in its mouth outside, and the resident was concerned. Goerzen explained kittens are OK with that. The resident seemed to be relieved, Goerzen said. Also this summer, Goerzen plans to go on a famiages 12 to 17. Those taking part volunteer several hours each week in June and July, working mostly with Life Enrichment to interact with residents in assisted living and health care.
