

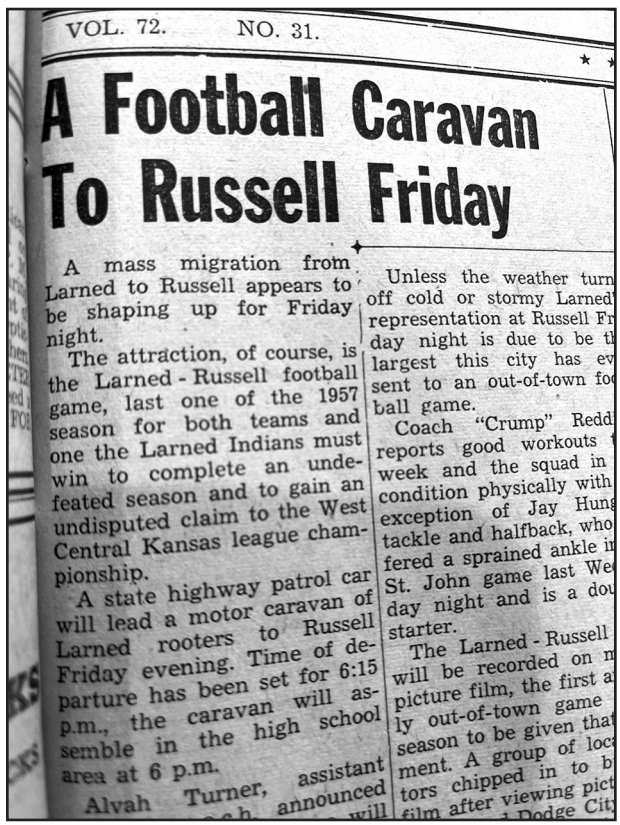
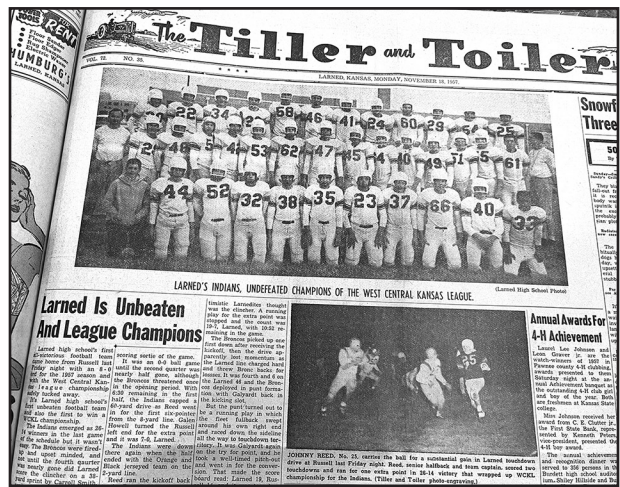
1957

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The Topeka Capital moved Larned up to number five in the all-classes poll after their victory behind Kansas City Wyandotte. Only Clay Center and Larned were Class A teams that made the top-five of the All Class rankings.

Basking in the afterglow of the undefeated season, the team was feted with the annual Football Banquet and the Kansas University Athletic Director, A.C. “Dutch” Lonborg was the guest speaker. He and the evening’s Toastmaster, Dr. O.R. Cram congratulated the team on their unusual 8-0 season and coach George “Crump” Redding gave a recap of the season.

Today, that 1957 football team’s exploits have probably grown to mythical proportions whenever a reunion is held but, that’s the way it should be. They made history and it is still history: 1957: Larned’s Only Undefeated Football Team!
