## NFL preseason debacle

With football season approaching quickly, I find myself holding my breath each and every day hoping to not get the most dreaded notification any football fan can get during this time of the year - "BREAKING NEWS! Patrick Mahomes out for season due to torn ACL."

Although that is a more biased take as myself and most other residents in the area are Kansas City Chiefs fans, that dreaded and horrible feeling of finding out a key or integral player on your favorite football team being out for the season is unmatched.

Whether your team has a realistic shot at the playoffs or not, every fanbase loves to use weeks leading up to the beginning of the season to explain why this is their year. However, there's no worse feeling than having those dreams burned to the ground following a devastating injury.

For me personally and a lot of other football fans out there, that begs the question of should NFL starters be playing in preseason games? One of the most famous preseason injuries to an NFL star was suffered by Michael Vick in 2003. After captivating fans throughout his sophomore campaign in 2002, Vick fractured his fibula in a preseason matchup against the Baltimore Ravens that caused him to miss the first 11 games of the season.

Within

decade, fellow NFL stars Jordy Nelson for the Green Bay Packers and Tony Romo for the Dallas Cowboys also suffered preseason injuries. In a 2015 preseason game, the Kansas State alum Nelson suffered a torn ACL against the Pittsburg Steelers that caused him to miss the entire season. In 2016, Romo sustained a broken bone in his back against the Seattle Seahawks in a preseason game that caused him to miss most of the season and allowed current Cowboys starting quarterback Dak Prescott to take charge of the position.

Fast forward to Saturday, August 10 of 2024, the Minnesota Vikings' No. 9 overall pick in the 2024 draft, former Michigan quarterback JJ McCarthy, suffered a season-ending injury in a preseason game against the Las Vegas Raiders due to a meniscus tear.

Before a promising rookie season could truly take flight, it ended with an 11-17, 188yard, two touchdown and one interception performance in less than one game of action in the preseason.

With McCarthy's injury being the latest of numerous big names going down in preseason games, it has raised the question once again of should starters play at all in preseason games. Whenever someone proposes that question to me, I love to answer them with something Bengal star quarterback Joe Burrow said regarding injuries - all NFL players know what they sign up for.

To put it simply, yes, I think starters should play in preseason games. I don't think it's necessary to play them in every preseason game, but I do believe it's important to make sure they get at least a quarter under their belt before the beginning of the regular season because there is nothing that can prepare you better for a game than playing, well,

a game. For those out there that think not playing starters in preseason games is the way to go, reference the New York Jets' regular season opener last season. In that game, newly acquired star quarterback Aaron Rodgers was supposed to bring the Jets back to glory. But, instead, the multi-MVP winning veteran's season came to a crashing end after his very first snap due to a torn achilles tendon.

The point? Crap happens. Of course you can't help but worry the worst when Patrick Mahomes or Travis Kelce takes the field for even one series in a preseason game, but the reality is that either of those players are just as likely to sustain a season-ending injury going for an evening jog as they are in a football game.

I'd rather my starting quarterback get game-time reps against opposing defenses than him watching from the sideline and then struggling in week one of the season because the only defense he has thrown a football against is his own in practice.
