



nders ps bv plugging away at their longest and strongest suit, while declarer at the same time attempts to resist their efforts to weaken his trump holding. Here is a typical case.

Assume West leads the queen of clubs, covered by the king and ace, and East returns a club. Declarer

ruffs and plays the A-K of trump, disclosing the 4-1 trump division. South is now in trouble and, in fact, can no longer make the contract. Let's say he draws West's two remaining trumps and then leads a diamond to the jack, taken by East with the ace.

East returns a third round of clubs, forcing South to ruff with his last trump. Declarer cashes the Q-K of diamonds but must next lead a heart. East wins with the ace and returns a club, and the contract is defeated because declarer lost control of the trump suit.

Now let's go back to the first trick and have South play the five of clubs from dummy instead of the king. In that case, West cannot lead another club without establishing a club trick in dummy. This, in turn, later prevents the defenders from effectively shortening declarer's trumps, and South has no trouble scoring 10 tricks.

It's not easy for declarer to see the necessity of playing a low club from dummy on the opening trick, but it is a play that cannot lose and might gain. The deal illustrates once again how important it is to formulate a plan before playing any card at trick one.
