City of Clyde Public Hearing Notice CDBG Community Facilities Application on behalf of Clyde Community Hall

The City of Clyde will hold a public hearing on Thursday, May 29th, at 7 pm in the City Hall at 412 Washington St. in Clyde, Kansas to consider an application to be submitted to the Kansas Department of Commerce for Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds under the Community Facilities: Large category. A specific project application to be discussed is the rehabilitation of the Clyde Community Hall in an area generally bounded by 401 Washington Street, Clyde, KS 66938 that includes, but is not limited to the following:

Exterior Items: tuckpointing of masonry; installing 24 new window units; replace exterior stairs to meet ADA; replace front door with automatic opener, update side, back and front entrances, replace the roof.

Interior Items: renovation of approximately 4214 square feet including updating/reconstructing two bathrooms and a kitchen; make total area ADA compliant; replace flooring, baseboards, ceilings and wall finishes; upgrade all electrical, HVAC and plumbing; install fire suppression system. Other budget items include administration, architectural de-

sign and construction inspection. The estimated project cost is \$925,000 with the grant request for \$650,000 of the project cost. Other project proposals introduced at the hearing will be considered. Oral and written comments will be recorded and become a part of the City of Clyde CDBG Citizen Participation Plan. Reasonable accommodations will be made available to persons with disabilities. Requests should be submitted to the City of Clyde, city clerk by noon, Tuesday May 27, 2025.
