KSU 2025 game themes announced

K-State Athletics has unveiled the official theme games for the 2025 football season at Bill Snyder Family Stadium, highlighting a blend of cherished traditions and community celebrations that will enhance the fan experience throughout the fall. The 2025 home schedule features six games in Manhattan, each with its own unique theme designed to showcase the pride, passion, and pageantry of K-State Football.

The season kicks off on Saturday,

August 30, against North Dakota with the annual Stripe Out game, where fans will don alternating purple and white based on their seating section to create a bold, unified visual across the stadium. On Saturday, September 6, K-State will host Fort Riley Day during its matchup with Army, paying tribute to the soldiers and families of Fort Riley through military displays, in-game recognitions, and a celebration of the university's longstanding military partnership.

Later in the month, the Wildcats welcome UCF on September 27 for Celebrate Ag Day, a gameday

dedicated to honoring the agriculture industry that drives Kansas' economy and sustains its communities. The theme games continue into October with Homecoming on Saturday, October 11, as alumni, students, and fans return to Manhattan for a week-long celebration that concludes with a spirited showdown against TCU.

One of the most anticipated traditions, Harley Day, returns on Saturday, November 1, when Texas Tech comes to town. Fans can expect the roar of more than 100 motorcycles circling the field in a thrilling pregame spectacle. Finally, the home schedule wraps

up on Saturday, November 29, against Colorado with Senior Day, a heartfelt tribute to the Wildcat seniors as they take the field at Bill Snyder Family Stadium for the final time. A pre-game ceremony will recognize their dedication and contributions to the program.

Single-game tickets for the 2025 season will be available exclusively to Ahearn Fund members beginning Tuesday, June 10, with public sales opening on Tuesday, June 17. Fans are encouraged to secure their seats early and be part of another unforgettable season of K-State Football.

Chiefs unveil '25 regular season schedule

The NFL released its 2025 schedule on Wednesday, and the Kansas City Chiefs are once again set for the spotlight. The defending AFC West champions are slated for eight standalone games, including seven in prime-time, with four of those taking place at GEHA Field at Arrowhead Stadium. Kansas City will also play on both Thanksgiving and Christmas Day this season.

The Chiefs kick off the 2025 campaign with a historic international opener, facing the Los Angeles Chargers in São Paulo, Brazil, on Friday, Sept. 5. The game marks the NFL's first-ever live broadcast on YouTube and the Chiefs' first international contest since 2023 in Frankfurt, Germany.

Kansas City's home opener comes in Week 2, when they host the defending Super Bowl champion Philadelphia Eagles in a Super Bowl LIX rematch on Sunday, Sept.

14. A primetime road game against the New York Giants follows on Sept. 21, before a return to Arrowhead to face the Baltimore Ravens on Sept. 28.

The Chiefs then travel to Jacksonville for a Monday Night Football clash with the Jaguars on Oct. 6, the first of two Monday night appearances this season. Kansas City will then play three straight at home—Detroit (Oct. 12), Las Vegas (Oct. 19), and Washington (Oct. 27)—before visiting Buffalo

on Nov. 2 in a rematch of the 2024 AFC Championship Game. The team will have its bye in Week 10.

Following the break, the Chiefs travel to Denver (Nov. 16) and then host the Colts (Nov. 23) before a Thanksgiving Day showdown against the Dallas Cowboys (Nov. 27). It marks Kansas City's 11th appearance on Thanksgiving and its first since 2006. The Chiefs hold a 5-5 all-time record on the holiday.

The final stretch of the

regular season includes three more AFC West games. Kansas City hosts Houston on Dec. 7 and the Chargers on Dec. 14, travels to Tennessee on Dec. 21, and then plays back-to-back division games to close the year: hosting the Broncos on Christmas Day and finishing at Las Vegas in Week 18.

This year's slate includes 10 matchups against teams that made the playoffs in 2024. The combined 2024 record of the Chiefs' opponents is 151-138 (.522).
