The Monarchs are now 12-0 on the season and traveled to Abilene Friday night. Next Friday, they take on the Russell/Victoria Broncos at home.

Girls notch 28 runs in sweep of Skyline

The Monarch softball team has made a name for themselves offensively, putting up double digits in all but three contests this season. Undeclared, they lean on their pitching staff to put away opponents on the defense, allowing them more time to dominate at the plate. The story remained the same Tuesday afternoon, taking down Skyline 14-3 and 14-2.

The Buffs loaded the bases with no outs to open their first game, quickly scoring on a pair of walks and hits to take the 6-0 lead. Six runners reached base in the first inning by walk or hit by pitch. Though Brynn Rebel struggled to find her stride in the first inning, she managed to get things rolling, issuing two walks and allowing just two runs to end the Thunderbird threat.

Her Monarchs had her back, notching five hits to open the second inning, up 8-2. The final Skyline run would score in the second inning, a pair of singles resulting in a run, 8-3.

The third inning saw the offense apply the pressure, Bria Windholz with a long ball over the center field fence. With all the insurance she needed, Rebel worked a three up three down inning to end the third, Monarchs ahead 11-3.

In the fourth, they would push that lead to 14-3, bringing the run rule into

effect after five innings. Both teams would work around runs and in the bottom of the fifth, the Monarchs put their opponents away with a double play. Windholz led TMP, 3-for-4 at the plate with 3 RBIs. Addison Watson was 1-for-3 with 3 RBIs.

Rebel improved to 9-0, now holding a 1.70 ERA in 37.1 innings pitched.

Game two saw Brooke Koenigsman wheel her way to third on a pair of triples, going 3-for-4 with 3 RBIs. Sister Paige Koenigsman went 2-for-3 with 3 RBIs. The Monarchs scored consistently, one run in the second, four in the third, six in the fourth and three in the fifth to earn the 14-2 victory.

Windholz notched win number seven on the mound, going five innings and allowing two runs (one earned) on three hits, three walks and eight strikeouts.

The Monarchs are now 16-0 on the season and took on Dodge City Friday night.
