tal services and EMS capabilities. Brenda suggested that various strategies could be employed to navigate the challenges previously outlined. Brenda asked Mickie a question regarding the out-of-county transfers to Trego County. She wanted clarity on why Graham County is involved in these transfers. Mickie provided insight into this situation, noting that since Trego County currently lacks its own EMS services, Graham County steps in to assist when resources permit. Brenda and Cole acknowledge that enhancements won't be overnight fixes, but the willingness to extend their help and improve services is clear. Brenda proposed a significant change regarding our EMS operations, suggesting that they be managed under the hospital's guidance. Brenda stated that for meaningful progress, it is essential for the commissioners to consider implementing changes in the current EMS management structure. The Commissioners offered thanks to Cole and Brenda for voicing their concerns. The Commissioner assured them that their feedback will not go unnoticed and will be staying on top of them to ensure ongoing improvements. Graham County Community Development-Dan Steffen Dan Steffen shared updates relevant to Graham County's ongoing projects., Dan has had some discussions with an individual looking to establish a treatment center in Graham Coun-

ty. The initiative promises collaboration with notable partners such as DREAM, High Plains Mental Health, and Valley Hope. He is also working to maintain continuity in leadership by reaching out to Jonathan in order to replace Melissa on the Workforce Board. Dan emphasized to the commissioners his preference for having the commissioners and the county clerk conduct the interviews for the director position. Dan inquired whether any consideration had been given to whether the director's position would be part-time, full-time, or eliminated altogether. After much discussion, it was decided to proceed with interviews, which will be scheduled for Tuesday, March 4th, beginning at 12:30 PM. New Business Commissioner Knoll made a motion to approve abatement orders 2025-01-2025-20, and Commissioner Nelson seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Irby made a motion to pass Resolution #2025-01, which is a resolution modifying the Road and Bridge Department's overtime pay. Commissioner Nelson seconded the motion. Motion carried 3-0. AP Vouchers were reviewed and signed by commissioners. Commissioner Nelson made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 11 & 14, 2025, meetings, which was seconded by Commissioner Irby. The motion passed 3-0.

Payroll vouchers and payroll payables were reviewed and signed by commissioners. Commissioner Knoll reviewed and signed the Abstract from February 4th Meeting. Commissioner Irby made a motion to have corrections come help with some project around the county whenever they are available to. Being aware that there are some new regulations that may only allow for 2 to 3 days a week. Commissioner Knoll seconded the motion, motion carried 3-0. Commissioner Irby stated that he felt it was a conflict of interest for him to remain the High Plains Mental Health Board and he has 2 individuals that are willing to replace him. He would like for that to be on the agenda next week. Graham County Road & Bridge-Wayne Pfeifer Wayne informed the commissioners that he has several workers out on Goddard Road, with the rest engaged in blading. After inspecting a road that had been reported, he didn't find it in poor condition but dispatched a blade to improve it anyway. John Deere and CAT had been out that morning, and Wayne mentioned that Norton has another blade available for sale. The commissioners expressed interest and instructed him to gather more information and report back. Commissioner Knoll made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Irby seconded it, motion carried 3-0.
