

Marcus recalled a story that his dad told that one minute James was standing next to a man and the next minute, that man was destroyed by mortar fire. James served two years in the Army and never wanted to fight again. After the tribute, Kylie Brummett sang the National Anthem followed by James Langley playing Taps. The weather was cool and a little gray but the flowers on the graves and the flags along the Avenue of Flags fluttered slightly in the breeze, making a pleasant day for family and friends who wanted to visit at the cemetery.
