When a comes to communicating with people of different generations. a's important to know what they value Lo engage Baby Boomers (born 1943-1964), encourage them to provide mentorship and learn together. Gen Xers (born 1965-1980) are independent, resilient and adaptable. To engage them, give them opportunities for leadership. To engage Millennials (born 1981-1996), include them in management and allow autonomy and tlexibility as family and social impact is important to them.
