construction staking; traf-fic control; 4,532 LF of 2" & 4" C900 (DR18) PVC pipe; 123 LF of 4" re-strained joint C900 PVC; 18 ea. 4" gate valves; 9 ea. 4"x4"x4" MJDI tees; 5 ea. 4"x4"x6" MJDI tees; 7 ea. 45 degree 4" MJDI bend; 1ea. 4"ax2" MJDI re-ducer; 5 ea. fire hydrant assembly; 9 ea. connection to existing water main; 16 ea. long service connection; 14 ea. short service connection; 110 LF of boring and Jacking; 110 LF of 8" steel casing; 2 ea. flushing hydrant as-sembly; 30 ea. meter pit lids; cold mix; erosion control, seeding; engineering design; construction engineering/ inspection; grant administration and environmental review.

The grant was funded all or in part from the Kansas Department of Commerce, Small Cities Community Development Block Grant funds. All aspects of the grant will be discussed, and oral and written comments will be recorded and become a part of the City of Timken's Citizen Participation Plan.
