Cougars kick off season Friday

The Otis-Bison High School football team will kick off the 2025 season on the road, playing Western Plains at Ransom. The Cougars were 6-4 last season.

This is the second year for Coach Marc Cowles and the Cougars to play 6-man football. This is Cowles 23rd year as coach, with a career record of 110-105. This is the first year for assistant coach Anton Foust.

"We are excited and again are ready to embrace the 6-man Classification. Having a year under our belt will help our players understand how the 6-man game is played and what it takes to win 6-man games. We have a nice balance of players from each grade which will allow us to play older kids and allow the development of the younger players without having to throw them right into the competitive ring," said Coach Cowles.

Returning offensive starters are seniors

Gavin Alloway and Kelson Juno. Returning defensive starters are Alloway and Juno as well as sophomore Aiden Ochs-

Alloway is returning as running back. He rushed last year for 570 yards on 80 carries and eight touchdowns. He had 15 receptions for 126 yards and two TDs, and recording 29 tackles as a defensive back.

Juno started last season at center, but led the team in receiving. He had 19 catches of 413 yards and 10 touchdowns, and also had a rushing TD. He had a fumble recovery return touchdown as well as an interception return touchdown. He had 23 tackles, including two sacks.

Ochs-Lohrey started every game last year at linebacker as a freshman. He led the team in tackles with 84 total tackles, including 54 solos, six tackles for a loss, two interceptions and one defensive touchdown.


