WHEREAS, K.S.A. 15-101 et seq. authorizes the Governing Body of the City of Otis, Kansas to provide for and manage all affairs in a general nature in the City; and
WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Otis, Kansas has the power to levy and fund certain projects, needs for the City, and therefore has the power to determine where funds can best be spent, and
WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Otis, Kansas has determined it is necessary to eliminate the Sanitation Fund that was established sometime before 1978. The City no longer needs a specific fund in its budget for said purpose
believes it in the best interest of the constituency to create such a fund for strategic planning and saving purposes.



ORDINANCE 2025-02 (Repeals Ordinance 125)
AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING NEW RATES OF SERVICE CHARGES FOR THE USE OF AND PROVIDING FOR THE CONNECTION TO THE WASTEWATER AND SEWAGE POLLUTION CONTROL SYSTEM OF THE RESIDENTS LIVING INSIDE AND OUTSIDE THE POLLUTION CONTROL DISTRICT #1 OF THE CITY OF LIEBENTHAL, RUSH COUNTY, KANSAS.
SECTION 1. Pursuant to section 12-613g, et seq., K.S.A. and any amendments thereto, the following new monthly service charges are hereby established for the use and or maintenance of said City's wastewater and sewage pollution control system:
(a) Residents inside wastewater and sewage pollution control District #1.....\$35.00
(b) Residents outside wastewater and sewage pollution control District #1...\$35.00
(c) Business establishments.....\$40.00
(d) School.....\$35.00
(e) Church.....\$35.00
SECTION 1.1 To ensure the City of Liebenthal has the financial ability to operate, maintain, and repair the Wastewater and Sewage Pollution Control system, the Governing Body of the City of Liebenthal shall reassess the current rates annually and reserves the right to repeal or establish new charges of not more than 5% per year as deemed necessary to ensure all state and federal regulations continue to comply in operation, maintenance, and repairs of said City's Wastewater and Sewer Pollution Control system. New rate increases shall commence on the 1st day of January.
SECTION 2. Said charges shall be paid to the office of the City Clerk.
SECTION 3. Subject to the approval of the Governing Body of the City of Liebenthal, residents located outside the City limits of said City may be permitted to connect to the City's wastewater and sewage pollution control collection system. A hook-up fee to be established by the Governing Body of the said City and agreed to by the resident to be served will be charged for the connection.
SECTION 4. Be it obtained that this Ordinance shall repeal Ordinance #125.
SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon being published one time in the official City newspaper.
