- (4) Wallace County—Afternoon of October 25, 2025 1 pm to 3:00 pm.

At the cleanup each county will accept old paint, herbicides and pesticides, batteries, used oil and anti freeze.

This is part of the ongoing program of each of the above counties to provide a means of proper disposal of hazardous substances commonly found in the home.

NOTICE OF CLOSING OF REGISTRATION BOOKS

In compliance with the provisions of K.S.A. 25-2310, notice is hereby given that the books for registration of voters will be open in the office of the County Clerk during normal business hours.

At 5:00 pm on the 14th day of October 2025, the books for registration of voters will close and remain closed until the 5th day of November 2025.

A citizen of the United States who is eighteen (18) at the next election must register before he or she can vote. Registration closes fourteen (14) days prior to every election.

When a voter has been registered according to law his or her registration shall continue to be valid until one of the following occurs:

The voter changes name by marriage, divorce or legal proceedings.

The voter changes residence.

If either of the above has occurred, you must reregister.

Any person may apply in person or by mail to the county election officer to be registered.

Application forms shall be provided by the County Election Officer upon request in person or in writing by an individual applicant. Such application shall be signed by the applicant under penalty of perjury.
