# Raven second half surge leads to victory over Pirates

Benedictine Women's Basketball bested Park University for the third time this season thanks to a 50-point second-half barrage that sealed a 77-52 win Tuesday night in the Heart Championships Quarterfinal at Ralph Nolan Gymnasium.

The Ravens struggled for the majority of the first half by shooting 32 percent from the floor and went into the locker room trailing 32-27.

BC finally asserted themselves in the third quarter thanks to their full-court press that led to a 25-7

run in the third quarter and 14 turnovers in the second half by the Pirates.

"Our team brought a ton of energy with the press tonight," Head Coach Chad Folsom said. "It transferred into us getting a lot of transition buckets."

The Ravens came into Tuesday night having dropped three of their last four games and faced potentially not making the field of the Women's Basketball National Championship.

"We all know we're kind of sitting in a spot where if we lost this it is probably the end of our season and six of our careers," Senior

Lauryn Dubbert said. "We wanted this one bad and to go from down five to win by 25 is big momentum going into Grandview."

Dubbert led BC with 18 points while sophomore Riley Bruggeman added 16 off the bench.

Both players also stepped up while senior Josie Weishaar battled foul trouble most of the first half and third quarter.

"Lauryn and Riley helped got things going with getting to the basket, hitting shots, and getting a

lot of things in transition," Folsom said. "They got things going for us really well."

Weishaar still managed to finish with 13 points. Senior Jennifer Jacobs recorded a double-double with 13 points and 10 rebounds. The Ravens outrebounded Park 45-34 on the night.

BC will now travel to Des Moines to take on the Grand View Vikings for the third time this season on Friday at 5:30 p.m.

The Ravens lost to the Vikings

Saturday at home 59-47 but won on the road 89-87 on February 3. This will be the second consecutive year these teams will meet for the third time.

"Both of us know each other pretty well," Folsom said. "This time of the year it is a matter of who is going to execute, defend, and take care of the ball better."

BC and Grand View split last season and the Vikings won 65-62 in the Heart Championships Semifinals.
