TIGERS GRAB FOURTH AT STATE

Atchison County Community High School wrestling grabbed the program's third straight topfive finish in Class 3-1A State Wrestling at Fort Hays State University with four wrestlers who were top-five finishers and two second-place wrestlers who were a breath away from a State Championship.

"We had goals of finishing higher and just weren't able to do it this season," Head Coach Cody Kramer said. "I'm very proud of the team's toughness and effort."

Senior Easton Schletzbaum and junior Max Bottorff both had heartbreaking finishes in the championship round. Schletzbaum lost in overtime at the 157 class while Bottorff lost at the last second of regulation for the 165 class.

"It is very tough to lose such high-level matches like that," Kramer said. "This sport is so tough and demanding."

This is Schletzbaum's third second-place finish in his career. He even wrestled all season with a torn knee that he is getting surgery on now. Sophomore Luke Smith finished in fifth place in the 126 class while fellow sophomore Elijah Webb finished in fourth place in the 190 class.

Kramer said if not for the injures his squad would've achieved their goal of finishing in the top three or higher.

"All season long guys had injures that require surgery and they kept wrestling," Kramer said. "That shows how tough our guys are and what they are willing to do to try and win. I believe if we had been healthy we would have finished in the top three."

AN ORDINANCE AMEND-ING SECTION 33-31(d)(4) OF THE CODE OF ORDINANC-ES, CITY OF ATCHISON AF-**FECTING SEWER RATES** BE IT ORDAINED BY THE

CITY OF ATCHISON, KAN-SAS: SECTION 1. That section 33-31(d)(4) (water rates) of the

GOVERNING BODY OF THE

Code of Ordinances, City of Atchison, Kansas, is hereby amended to read in full as follows: (4) Billing rate. The minimum

base rate per month shall be: (a) Industrial Sewer rates outside of City Limits. The monthly base fee for any industry located outside of city limits discharging into the wastewater system, shall be calculated at a base rate of \$4,040.00 per month plus a charges of \$0.04141 per gallon of wastewater dis-

(b) Beginning in 2025 and thereafter, for the first five thousand (5,000) gallons of water consumed each month or any part thereof shall have a minimum monthly base rate of \$27.56. For low-income elderly qualified customers, the minimum monthly base rate shall be \$21.83.

charged.

For all usage in excess of the aforementioned five thousand (5,000) gallons per month, the applicable rate shall be \$5.50 per additional one thousand (1,000) gallons of water (or wastewater), and for low income elderly qualified

customers, the excess rate shall be \$4.36 per additional one thousand (1,000) gallons of water (or wastewater).

SECTION 2. In any section, provision or parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. Section (d)(4) of ordinance 6716 is repealed SECTION 4. Ordinance 6717 is repealed.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication once in the official City newspaper and commencing for the April 2025 billing.
