Catchweed Bedstraw in Hay Fields

One of the more common weeds noted in many cool season hay stands this year is one that may be unfamiliar. Catchweed bedstraw, historically used as mattress filling (thus the name bedstraw...) may not be noticed at all – until of course it grabs at your boots or pant legs as you walk through it or results in thin areas of grass stands. Once it gets a foothold, catchweed bedstraw can be a real issue. It likes open space in moist shady areas, but survives well in drier environments once established. It can tolerate freezing temperatures and grows quickly to produce seed to survive another generation. Plants grow along the ground and can climb over other plants, fitting in wherever it can to survive.

Mowing isn't a great option and may even increase the plant's spread. When reseeding thin areas killed out by catchweed bedstraw,

keep in mind the aforementioned seeds. They'll be buried and likely come up again in the new stand as well.

There are multiple herbicide options including products containing fluroxypyr, halauxifen, quinclorac, dicamba,

MCPA, and carfentrazone. Spot treatments with glyphosate can also work but will damage desirable forages. When using products,

make sure you read and follow label restrictions on haying/grazing/use following application. An integrated approach that keeps desired forages competitive with weeds is a good option as well. Make sure hay fields are mowed at an appropriate height and pastures aren't overgrazed. Open space provides an opportunity for seed germination that can give this weed a real foothold. Late season scouting for issues like drought stress or armyworm injury are important as well so we stay aware of thin spots that can become covered in catchweed bedstraw if given the space to do so.
