For each line item, the firm divided the number by five (for each month) then multiplied that figure by 12 (creating a yearly estimate based on a monthly average).

The term "Revenue Neutral Rate" has become a term when the state legislators passed a law years ago, requiring government entities, including school districts, to contact the county clerk and publish notice of an intent to "exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate." The deadline for filing with the county is July 20 and requires public mailings of the notice.

Publishing the proposed budgets in legal newspapers is nothing new to Kansas politics, but the Revenue Neutral Rate implies the tax rate (property taxes) for the current year would generate the same property tax revenue as levied the previous year. This does not necessarily mean the same mill levy, depending on assessed property
