"Homeschool Tackle Box" to help families reel in learning

Authors Nancy Piercy and Sue Nothstine have released a guide for homeschooling in "Homeschool Tackle Box," published by Amazing Things Press in 2023.

Both Piercy and Nothstine were longtime friends who were teaching at the same high school. During the last four years of their careers, they created and ran the Starting Block at-risk program, which was aimed for students who failed their freshman year in high school; in the program, students were able to catch up with their academics

and catch up with their class. After retirement, Piercy and Nothstine collaborated with Dean of Northwest Missouri State University Dr. Joyce Piveral to write their first "Teacher's Tackle Box" book designed for first year teachers. After publishing that book, Piercy and Nothstine spent several years presenting workshops to new teachers and showed them how to get to know their students personal on an emotional and academic level.

"Homeschool Tackle Box" is designed to help guide homeschool educators through the process of developing what's called a Personal Learning

Profile for each of their children and themselves; the book also features help topics regarding learners' personality styles. The personal learning profile is important because the homeschool educator's profile could be different than that of their children's profile. If teachers teach the way they learn, the children may not learn the same way they teach.

The book also goes into what is included in the Personal Learning Profile, as it includes information about different personality types, learning styles,


