

Brian Bailey, deputy parks and recreation director for the city, said pancakes will be served during the event. He said there will also be dance performances.

"People will be able to take photos with Santa Claus as well," he said.

The C.W. Parker Carousel Museum, 320 S. Esplanade St., will host the Children's Small Mall from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Saturday. It will be offered again from 10 a.m. to 4 pm. Sunday

This will be the 20th year for the event, which gives children an opportunity to shop for Christmas gifts for family members and friends, according to Cyndi Peters, who is a volunteer for the museum.

"It's a special one because it's our 20th," she said.

The event is intended for children who are 3 to 13 years old.

Peters said parents fill out forms listing the people their children will be shopping for and provide money for the purchases.

Peters said gifts are priced at \$5 and \$7.
