high school," Watson said. "We've seen other school districts make a video and have that person actually talk. # User fees take effect at rec centers

Stewart acknowledges that when the city first promoted the sales tax to fund the Anthony and Eisenhower Recreation Centers to voters in 2016, it promised to keep the facilities free.

"Personally, it's not something I probably would have suggested, however that was part of the advertising," he said. "I recognize we're going back on what they said when they passed that tax, but also the pro forma changed. Originally, the rec centers were supposed to be separate buildings on the backside of the schools, not attached. They were supposed to be half the size, only two courts and not four."

He said the resulting design forced the department to run a public half of the facilities during the day which

was not anticipated in the initial design.

"We added all the cost of running it during the day, but did not go back and change the fee structure to match," he said. "We could go to that model, where we only operate the rec centers in the evenings and weekends publicly, but most people like having them open during the day, so this was a means to keep the same level of service going, but we needed to add the additional fee to help cover the additional costs that weren't

anticipated." The department continues to host sports tournaments regularly at the recreation centers. Stewart said those were initially supposed to cover the costs for running the facilities. With the user fee in place, he said they will continue to always have

at least one court open and available at one of the rec centers for drop in use.

Under the new fee structure, family memberships cost \$30 per month or \$330 for an annual membership, and are available to families with two adults and two children or one adult and three children.

Individual memberships cost \$10 per month, or \$100 annually. The city will charge \$5 per month for each additional child and \$55 for annual memberships.

A \$3 daily drop-in fee is also available to residents who don't wish to purchase a membership.

Stewart said if cost is a burden, scholarships are available through the Manhattan Parks and Rec Foundation to qualifying families.
