"It's truly a blessing," Crawford said. "God gifted me with the athletic ability to play these sports at the collegiate level, and I couldn't be more thankful and happy."

Crawford was recruited to play safety for the football program. He will compete in the long and the triple jump in track and field.

"I was having a hard time deciding what sport I wanted to do," Crawford said. "Southwestern came along and said I could do both, and I knew that was the place I wanted to be."

Crawford will be joining his cousin, Isaiah Roseberry, at Southwestern College.

"The deciding factor to sign with Southwestern was the fact that my cousin goes there as well," Crawford said. "To be able to play football with my cousin at

the collegiate level and do everything with him is a special thing not many get to experience."

Crawford started playing flag football when he was 5. He began playing tackle football in the fifth grade. He went out for track in seventh grade, but the season was

canceled due to Covid-19. Crawford competed in his first season of track and field in eighth grade.

"In track, the results are all up to you," he said. "There isn't a team to depend on. I love the brotherhood that you have in football. It is a second family that gets to

do what they love every day and compete."

Paola coach Mike Smith was at the singing for Crawford. Smith coached Crawford in football and track and field.

"It was exciting to have JJ sign with Southwestern for football and track," Smith said. "He is an amazing athlete and a hard worker. He was multi-year starter for us in football and an Elson Award winner."

Crawford was the Class 4A state runner-up in the triple jump last season.

Crawford joins another football program with a familiar face on the coaching staff. Mike Smith's son, Drew, is the defensive coordinator at Southwestern College.

"JJ Crawford has been a leader for us in football and track," coach Mike Smith said. "It was neat to see him sign with Drew, who is a Paola and Southwestern graduate. We are looking forward to big things from him moving forward with his college career."

"It was cool and meaningful to have coach Drew Smith there," Crawford said. "It shows how much he truly cares about his players."

Crawford made team-leading 80 tackles. He had six tackles for a loss of yards.


