Brown Hotel and Supper Club Phase I - Remodel

1.1 PROJECT SCOPE

A. The project consists of removing the existing roof membrane and any insulation down to the wood decking. The scope includes replacing rotted decking, minor structural repairs, installing a new TPO roofing system with associated insulation and products. Contractor shall provide manufacture roofing warranty as specified and workmanship warranty. Masonry pointing and repairs on portions of the building. Removal of all hazardous materials and disposed of legally.

B. The scope also includes a series of bid alternates; they may be accepted in no particular order. These include 3 new water line taps (sprinkler, commercial and domestic) associated digging and street repairs. Two new sewer line taps, digging and associated street repairs. Restoration and reinstallation of the porch railing and associated structural repairs and new TPO Roofing system. Basement floor demolition and legal disposal. Hazardous material removal and legal disposal.

1.4 CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

A. Drawings and Specifications are available upon deposit of \$250.00 for each set, plus \$30.00 postage and handling for each shipment. The deposit will be refunded in the amount of \$25 providing depositor submits a bona fide bid and returns set(s) in good condition within 10 days after bid opening; or depositor returns documents in good condition at least 5 days prior to bid opening.

C. BID SECURITY AND BONDS

1. Bid Security of 5% will be required in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders.

2. Bonds will be required in accordance with the Supplementary Conditions.

3. Performance & Payment Bonds are required and costs for the bond shall be included in the contract sum.

4. Surety Bonds are required and costs for the bond shall be included in the contract sum.

1.5 CDBG AND SECTION 3

A. The project is being partially funded by Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Program managed by the Kansas Department of Commerce. The contractor and their subcontractors on this project will be required to comply with the federal Davis-Bacon Act; Copeland "Anti-Kickback" Act; and the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act. Wage rates paid for construction work shall be at least equal to the prevailing wage rates as determined by the Secretary of the U. S. Department of Labor. The Labor Standards and Wage Rates Determination are included in the Contract Documents.

B. All persons awarded and/or entering into contracts with the Owner shall be subject to and required to comply with applicable county, state and federal provisions pertaining to nondiscrimination, labor standards, equal employment opportunity and affirmative action on public contracts.

C. Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and Federal prevailing wage rates to be paid under the contract, Section 3 of the 1968 Housing and Urban Development Act, Segregated Facility, Section 109 of the 1974 Housing and Community Development Act, the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Executive Order 11246 and Buy America Build America Act.

D. Minority Business Enterprises (MBE), Women Business Enterprises (WBE), and Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) are encouraged to submit bids for this work.

The City of Neodesha is asking that all residents of Neodesha contact Kansas One-Call or the City offices before digging, landscaping, fencing or building of any structural projects.

Public Notice

Kansas House Bill No. 2041 requires anyone who engages in any type of excavation to provide advance notice of at least two full working days, excluding weekends and holidays, to Kansas One-Call.

Kansas One-Call is the communication link between the excavator and the underground facility owner. Kansas One-Call does not locate any underground facility itself.

Kansas One-Call, 1-800-DIG-SAFE, is open 24 hours, seven days a week. Calls after 5:00 p.m. or before 7:30 a.m., on weekends and on holidays are accepted for emergencies only. Holidays are defined by state laws as "any proclaimed local, state or federal holiday".

Kansas One-Call can accept and process essentially three types of calls:

- Excavation or demolition
- Survey requests for planning purposes
- Emergency locate requests

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
