RESOLUTION NO. 2025-19

A RESOLUTION FINDING THAT CERTAIN STRUCTURES LOCATED AT 406 S. SANTA

Abbreviated Legal Description: PATTONS ADDITION, Lot 5, Block 2, Less West 100 feet

FE ST., DESCRIBED AS:

ARE UNSAFE OR DANGEROUS AND DIRECTING THAT SUCH STRUCTURES BE REPAIRED OR REMOVED, AND THAT THE PREMISES MADE SAFE AND SECURE.

WHEREAS, the public officer for the City of Frontenac did, on the 27th day of August 2025, file with the Governing Body of the City of Frontenac, a statement in writing that the structures located on the property as described above, commonly known as 406 S. Santa Fe St., are unsafe and dangerous; and,

WHEREAS, the Governing Body did by Resolution 2025-13, dated the 27th day of August 2025, fix the time and place of a hearing at which the owner, his or her agent, any lienholders, any occupants and all other parties of interest of such structures could appear and show cause why such structures should not be condemned and ordered repaired or demolished, and provided for giving notice thereof as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, Resolution 2025-13 was published in the official city newspaper on the 30th day of August 2025 and on the 6th day of September 2025, and a copy of said Resolution was served upon all persons entitled thereto as provided by law; and,

WHEREAS, at least 30 days have elapsed between the last publication and the date set for the hearing as required by law; and,

WHEREAS, on the 8th day of October 2025, the Governing Body did conduct a hearing scheduled by Resolution 2025-13 to hear all evidence submitted by the enforcing officer of the city and the owner, his or her agent, any lienholder of record, any occupants and any other interested parties.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF FRONTENAC, THAT:

The Governing Body hereby finds that the structures located on the property at 406 S. Santa Fe. St. are unsafe and dangerous and directs that such structures are to be repaired or removed and the premises made safe and secure.

The owner of the property is hereby directed to commence the repair or removal of the structures to bring them into compliance with applicable building, residential, electrical, fuel gas, plumbing, and mechanical codes adopted by Frontenac City Code Chapter 4, within 30 days from the date of publication of this Resolution, and to have the repairs completed within 90 days of the date of commencement of the ordered repair. Provided that upon due application by the owner and for good cause shown, the Governing Body, in its sole discretion, may grant the owner additional time to complete the repair of the property. The City Building Inspector is authorized by law to enter such buildings, structures or premises at all reasonable times to inspect the same and to exercise any power or authority or to perform any duty imposed upon him.

The City Building Inspector shall make written progress reports to the Governing Body.

If the owner fails to commence the repair of the structures within the time stated herein, or any additional time granted by the Governing Body, or fails to diligently prosecute the same until the work is completed, the Governing Body will cause, without further notice, the structures to be razed and removed and the costs of razing and removing, less salvage if any, shall be assessed against the lot or parcel of land upon which the structures are located or by both, in the manner provided by K.S.A. 12-1755, and amendments thereto.

This Resolution shall be published once in the official newspaper, and a copy mailed to the owners, agents, lienholders, occupants, and other parties of interest.
