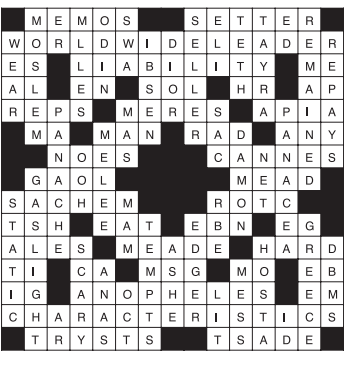

ing farmers' markets from authorized vendors, which will be identified with signage showing they are authorized to accept the coupons.
Two of the vendors at Fredonia's Farmer's Markets participate in this program, Studebaker Acres and Zoe's Produce (Billie Fulghum). Local markets are held Tuesday mornings and Friday afternoons at the First United Methodist Church yard, 8th and Madison.
Eligible foods to purchase with the KSFMNP are defined as "fresh, nutritious, unprepared, fruits and vegetables, locally produced honey, and cut herbs that are grown in Kansas."
Seniors can find more information about eligibility requirements and how to apply for the KSFMNP program or where to use the KSFMNP coupons by visiting the KSFMNP website.
