WOODSON COUNTY law enforcement was present during the lockdown at the Yates Center Elementary School Monday, May 5 after anonymous threats were made. The incident was resolved with no issues at the location.

YC school locked down

USD #366 Elementary School and the pre-school were on lockdown Monday, May 5 after a report of an “intend to harm” was reported.

Woodson County officials were notified by Allen County law enforcement of an email that was sent to a crisis center that stated an unknown, suicidal individual intended to enter a

pre-school and harm staff and students. The call came to Allen County due to an internet service provider located in Allen County. No location was given of the intended location.

Area officials in several counties were notified, took appropriate action and the Kansas Bureau of Investigation was called to assist. It was later

determined, by back tracking the ISP address from the email, the threat was from a server in Lawrence. A juvenile student in Lawrence was later detained in connection with the incident. Charges are pending. Classed resumed normal operations Tuesday.
