

Sesquicentennial Labor Day Weekend #28 Tragedy was no stranger to the citizens of Yates Center. About 4 p.m., August 6, 1910, Earl Sanford, son of Mrs. Caps of the City, was killed instantly in the Woodson County Courtyard. He was swinging on the cap rocks over the entrance to the ladies' restroom when it broke, the rocks falling on him and breaking his neck. The accident was witnessed by a friend who reported that he didn t move

after he struck the ground. The cap rocks were Carthage limestone, about six inches wide and five inches thick. These cap rocks were simply laid on top of the walls and were not anchored or tied.
