Sesquicentennial Labor Day Weekend

#29 The Woodson County Advocate, April 23, 1897 I went home that night, but every time I would drop off to sleep, I would see that cursed thing with the big lights and hideous people. I don t know whether they were devils or what, but we all saw them, and my whole family saw the ship, and I don t want anything more to do with them! One

hundred twenty-eight years ago, the world was startled by a story told by Alexander Hamilton concerning an airship manned by some sort of foreigners who swooped low over the Hamilton Ranch near Vernon and roped a heifer from the feed lot. The Woodson County Advocate originally

printed the story. It was picked up by other weekly newspapers and eventually by the big city dailies in more or less full form. Of interest is that several reports of these unidentified flying ships were reported over various locations in the US between March and April 1897! (To Be Continued)
