RESOLUTION NO. 25-13
A RESOLUTION GOVERNING WOODSON COUNTY ROADS UNDER COUNTY CONTROL, ALL IN WOODSON COUNTY, KANSAS REQUIRING COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAYS BE CLEAR OF OBSTRUCTIONS; PARKING OF VEHICLES AND/OR EQUIPMENT ON RIGHT OF WAYS PROHIBITED.

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas that, in the interest of public safety and proper maintenance and repair of Woodson County roads it is prudent to require all right of ways along said county roads be clear of obstructions.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF WOODSON COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The parking of vehicles and/or equipment within county right of ways along county roads is hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2. Should any vehicle, vehicles, and/or equipment be parked within a County right of way, the Woodson County Sheriff shall provide written notice to the owner of record of the property upon which the vehicle, vehicles, and/or equipment is located informing said owner of the need to remove the vehicle, vehicles, and/or equipment within thirty (30) days of owner's receipt of the written notice.

SECTION 3. In the event

the vehicle, vehicles, and/or equipment are removed within the thirty-day period, no additional action will be taken in this instance.

SECTION 4. In the event the vehicle, vehicles, and/or equipment is not removed within the thirty (30) day period, the Board of Commissioners of Woodson County, Kansas may assess a fine of up to \$500.00 and/or order the vehicle, vehicles, and/or equipment removed and all costs related to removal be assessed to the property owner of record.

SECTION 5. Should parking of a vehicle, vehicles, and/or equipment occur on subsequent occasions, each such occasion shall constitute a new violation. Second and subsequent violations may be punishable by a fine of no less than \$100 and no more than \$500 for each vehicle and/or piece of equipment parked on the county right of way. These fines are in addition to any costs incurred by Woodson County in removing the vehicle, vehicles and/or equipment.

SECTION 6. This Resolution shall take effect upon publication in the official county newspaper.
