The big news was about grasshoppers; the story was published in the Woodson County Post on August 26, 1874. It read: The grasshoppers are here in quantities to suit almost everyone. They made their debut last Saturday afternoon, and if their object was to create a sensation, their first appearance was a success. We trust that the asshoppers will soon eat everything up and leave in time to sow wheat. September 2, 1874, The

grasshoppers are taking everything green in the county. September 14, 1874, Rose. KS: Plenty of rain. The grasshoppers are nearly all gone. Eminence and Perry townships are to lose a lot of their citizens. Moving back East and North. The cause chinch bugs and grasshoppers. 1874 was the second year in a row with failed crops in Woodson County. The culprits in 1873 were chinch bugs and drought, while crop failures in 1874 were because of grasshoppers!
