Broadway Avenue, Abilene, KS 67410 and then publicly opened and read aloud, for furnishing all labor, materials and equipment and performing all work necessary to: Construct T-Hangar. The Owner's award of this contract is conditioned upon the bidder satisfying the good faith effort requirements of 49 CFR § 26.53.
