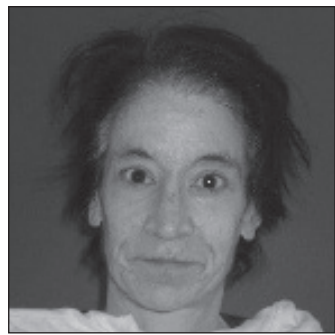
## Anonymous Groups
