COMES NOW the State of Kansas, by and through counsel, Kathleen Munch Britton, Chief Assistant District Attorney, and provides notice of a hearing as follows:

A petition pertaining to the parental rights to the child whose name appears above has been filed in this Court requesting the Court to find the child is a child in need of care as defined in the Kansas Code for the Care of Children. If a child is adjudged to be a child in need of care and the Court finds a parent to be unfit, the Court may permanently terminate that parent's parental rights. The Court may also make other orders including, but not limited to, requiring a parent to pay child support.

On August 3, 2026 at 1:30 PM each parent and any other person claiming legal custody of the minor child is required to appear for an Adjudication and Disposition Hearing as to the Father and Permanency Hearing in the Juvenile Division at the Douglas County Law Enforcement and Judicial Center, 111 E 11th Street, Lawrence, Kansas. Each parent has the right to be represented by an attorney. A parent that is not financially able to hire an attorney may apply to the court for a court appointed attorney. A request for a court appointed attorney should be made without delay to: Clerk of the District Court; ATTN: Juvenile Division; 111 East 11th Street; Lawrence Kansas 66044-9202. Danielle Packer, an attorney in Lawrence, Kansas, has been appointed as guardian *ad litem* for the child. Craig Stanciliffe, an attorney in Lawrence, Kansas, has been appointed to represent the mother. Jody Meyer, an attorney in Lawrence, Kansas, has been appointed to represent the father.

All parties are hereby notified that if you fail to appear in person or by counsel at the hearing, Petitioner will proffer or offer evidence in your absence which the court may rely on to make finding of fact and law.

On or about July 21, 2026, the City of Lawrence will submit a request to the US Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the release of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Entitlement funds under Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake the following project:

Comprehensive Rehabilitation of a single-family home located at 2618 Missouri St, Lawrence, KS, in an established residential neighborhood. Work will include foundation repair and roof and gutter replacement. Estimated funding for this project is \$60,000.

The activities proposed are categorically excluded under HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58 from National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) requirements. An Environmental Review Record (ERR) that documents the environmental determinations for this project is on file at City of Lawrence Planning and Development Services office, 6 E 6th St, Lawrence, KS 66044 and may be examined or copied weekdays 9 A.M to 4 P.M. The ERR may also be examined online at www.lawrenceks.org/pds/reports_plans/.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the City of Lawrence Planning and Development Services office, 6 E 6th St, Lawrence, KS 66044, or to the Housing Initiatives Division at housing-initiatives@lawrenceks.gov. All comments received by July 20, 2026 will be considered by the City of Lawrence prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The City of Lawrence certifies to HUD that Casey N. Toomay in her capacity as Acting City Manager consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental

review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. HUD's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the City of Lawrence to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

HUD will accept objections to its release of fund and the City of Lawrence's certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Lawrence; (b) the City of Lawrence has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by HUD; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD at Kansas City Regional Office, 400 State Avenue Room 200, Kansas City, KS 66101-2406, or CPD_GeneralCorr-R7@hud.gov. Potential objectors should contact HUD to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
