CHARTER RESOLUTION NO. 2026-2

A CHARTER RESOLUTION AMENDING CHARTER RESOLUTION 12-93, EXEMPTING CRAWFORD COUNTY, KANSAS FROM K.S.A. 12-16,101 AND ANY ACT AMENDATORY THEREOF AND PROVIDING SUBSTITUTE PROVISIONS ON THE SAME SUBJECT.

WHEREAS, K.S.A. 12-16-101, as amended, applies to Crawford County, does not apply uniformly to all 105 counties in Kansas, and does not apply to a subject which is preempted by, or upon which the exercise of home rule power by a county is prohibited by, State law, and is, therefore subject to Home Rule by Charter Resolution duly adopted by a Board of County Commissioners pursuant to K.S.A. § 19-101a, -101b, as amended:

WHEREAS, the current number of ten (10) members on the Convention and Tourism Committee was adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on August 12, 1986 and has remained the same;

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that an increase to up to (15) in the number of members on the Convention and Tourism Committee is necessary to allow for the expansion of the number of hotels in Crawford County.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the following charter resolution be adopted:

Section 1. Crawford County, Kansas, by the power vested in it under K.S.A. 19-101 et seq., as amended, hereby amends Charter Resolution No. 12-93, elects to not be governed by and to exempt itself from, and does hereby exempt itself from and makes inapplicable to Crawford County the provisions of K.S.A. 12-16,101, as amended.

Section 2. That the following substitution is adopted and is hereby applicable to Crawford County, Kansas:

CONVENTIONAND TOURISM COMMITTEE; APPOINTMENT; TERMS; CONTRACTSAND PROGRAMS.

(a) So long as there as there is a transient guest tax levied under K.S.A. 12-1697 et seq., as amended, in Crawford County, Kansas, the Board of County Commissioners of Crawford County, Kansas may establish a convention and tourism committee, to be known as the Crawford County Convention and Visitors Bureau Advisory Board, to make recommendations to the Board of County Commissioners concerning the programs and expenditures for promotion of conventions and tourism.

(b) Such convention and tourism committee shall be comprised of no less than nine (9) and no more than fifteen (15) residents of, or people employed in, Crawford County, Kansas. Members are appointed by the Board of County Commissioners of Crawford County, Kansas, in December of each year, with terms to run from January 1 to December 31. The composition of the Advisory Board shall be as follows: five (5) to eleven (11) members who are representatives of motels, hotels, bed and breakfast establishments, tourist courts, hunting and fishing industry, agritourism, casino gaming, Crawford County Fair, Arts or Cultural Events, or Festivals, or other businesses, firms, organizations, agencies or facilities involved or engaged in, or impacts the convention or tourism business in and around Crawford County, Kansas. When available, at least two (2) of such members shall be representatives of motels, hotels, bed and breakfasts, and other lodging establishments. The remaining four (4) to ten (10) members are appointed at large. In appointing such members, the Board of County Commissioners shall attempt to create a representative balance of large and small businesses, firms, organizations, agencies, and facilities and choose those from the various geographic areas of Crawford County.

(c) The Board of County Commissioners shall, by motion or resolution, provide for the appointment of such members of the Crawford County Convention and Visitors Bureau Advisory Board and the term of service of such member; provided however, that from and after the effective date hereof, members shall be appointed for a period not to exceed three (3) years, or the balance of any unexpired term being filled in the event of a vacancy, whichever is less. One-third of the board terms shall expire each year and no such member shall serve more than two (2) consecutive terms as such member, except in the case of, a) the two members who represent lodging facilities, who are eligible for reappointment to additional consecutive full terms in the event sufficient applications are not received from other persons eligible to represent lodging facilities, and b) any officer who is currently serving as the Chair of the Board or in succession as Vice Chair of the Board, to complete the terms and duties of their office.

(d) The Board of County Commissioners may, by motion or resolution, designate such ex-officio members of the Crawford County Convention and Visitors Bureau Advisory Board, who shall not be voting members thereof, as the Board of County Commissioners shall deem to be in the best interest of Crawford County, its citizens, and the operation of the Crawford County Convention and Visitors Bureau.
(e) The Board of County Commissioners shall have the authority to enter into contracts for the implementation of convention and tourism programs in and around Crawford County.

Section 3. Charter Resolution 12-93 is hereby amended to conform to the terms hereof as restated by this Charter Resolution No 2026-2, and any and all prior motions, resolutions and actions considered, adopted or taken by the Board of County Commissioners in conflict with the provisions of this Charter Resolution are hereby amended, rescinded or repealed, as the case may be, as of the effective date of this Charter Resolution No 2026-2.

Section 4. Pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 19-101b(b), this Charter Resolution shall be published once each week for two consecutive weeks in the official County newspaper.

Section 5. This Charter Resolution shall become effective sixty-one (61) days after final publication, unless a sufficient petition for a referendum is filed and a referendum held on the resolution, as provided by K.S.A. 19-101b, in which case the resolution shall become effective upon, and only upon, the approval of a majority of the electors voting thereon.
