Families in Harper County will have the opportunity to receive free, in-person assistance with KanCare enrollment during a monthly outreach event hosted at the Harper County Health Department.

A Healthy Kansas Kids Community Outreach representative will be available every second Wednesday of the month from 11:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at the Harper County Health Department, located at 123 N. Jennings Ave. in Anthony, to answer

questions and help families complete the Families with Children KanCare application. No appointment is necessary.

Participants are strongly encouraged to bring Social Security cards and proof of household income from the past 30 days to ensure applications can be completed efficiently. The service is free and bilingual, making assistance accessible to more families in the community.

KanCare provides health coverage for eligible Kansas children and families, help-

ing ensure access to essential medical services.
