## CITY OF GIRARD - ORDINANCE 1401

Published March 12, 2026.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 1, SECTION 117 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GIRARD PERTAINING TO ANIMAL IMPOUNDMENT.

### ORDINANCE 1401

**Section 1.** Impoundment; fee; notice; record.

(a) The animal control officer or law enforcement officer shall impound any animal or fowl found at large in the city or constituting a nuisance or otherwise in violation of this chapter in a suitable pound or enclosure provided or contracted for by the city. The impounding officer shall make diligent inquiry as to the owner of the animal and shall notify the owner thereof of such impoundment as soon as reasonably possible.

(b) The city shall be entitled to receive from such owner an impoundment fee of \$20 plus \$30 for each day the animal has been impounded, a licensing fee if the animal is required to be licensed and is not, a refundable rabies vaccination deposit of \$25 if licensing is required and the animal does not have a current vaccination, and a refundable sterilization deposit of \$100 if the animal is being placed for adoption. All fees and deposits shall be paid to the city clerk and a receipt therefore presented to the animal control officer before an animal may be released from the animal shelter. Subsequent impounds occurring within 12 months shall be charged double impoundment fees. In addition to the payment of fees and deposits, the owner of an impounded animal may also be proceeded against for violation of this article.

(c) The animal control officer shall each month submit a report to the mayor showing the number of animals impounded and disposed of, and the fees collected pursuant to this article and shall pay those fees to the city clerk for credit to the general operating fund.

**Section 2.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication according to law.


